WHAT TO WEAR

♣ Typically, you can expect modest weather during the day and cool evenings. Bring a light jacket and check weather.com for chance of rain.

Men/Women Attire:

- **♣** Clothing will be consistent with Christian principles.
- ♣ All garments will be neither tight fitting nor extremely oversized. They will not be sheer or worn in a way to expose undergarments, intimate body parts, chest, back or abdomen:
- ♣ Bermuda length shorts are acceptable student wear, <u>but</u> may not be worn when attending chapel, assemblies, special convocations, church, or other religious services.
- ♣ Short dresses or skirts (i.e., mini) are not considered representative of the university or in accord with university values on or off campus.

Jewelry:

♣ Students should not wear ornamental jewelry of any kind (chains, bracelets, earrings, tongue and toe rings, or nose rings).

Cosmetics:

♣ Students should avoid the noticeable use of cosmetics.

Hairstyles:

♣ Students should avoid extreme, faddish hairstyles and colors
